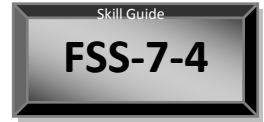

Description: This Skill Guide is intended to instruct and/or evaluate members of a RIT using a sounding PASS device from a downed firefighter to assist in locating them.

Search Techniques- PASS Assisted

Task: Locate a downed firefighter using their PASS device as a homing beacon.

Conditions: In a simulated IDLH atmosphere, with zero visibility, wearing full PPE including SCBA, a RIT will locate a downed firefighter using the downed firefighters PASS device as a homing beacon. The RIT will maintain team integrity and communications with IC and the downed firefighter or downed firefighters partner using a radio or verbal communications.

	Objectives	P	F
1.	RIT Prepares for Deployment (S.G. FSS-6-2)		
2.	RIT leader communicates objectives and search method to be used to team members and IC and search method. i.e wall (left hand or right hand, hose, or rope to maintain orientation)		
3.	RIT Leader communicates to downed firefighter or downed firefighters partner to turn on PASS device if not already sounding		
4.	RIT leader communicates to downed firefighter or partner of downed firefighter to turn off PASS device to communicate via radio or verbal, and requests all quiet to hone in on location if able.		
5.	Team leader maintain situational awareness and tactical accountability		
6.	Team leader maintain Air management of entire team		
7.	Team locates and assess downed firefighter per (S.G. FSS-8-1)		
Performance Outcome; A RIT will be able to demonstrate the ability to locate a downed firefighter (and partner if scenario permits) using a PASS device as a homing beacon. The downed firefighter or partner of downed firefighter will secure the PASS device if able during radio communications
