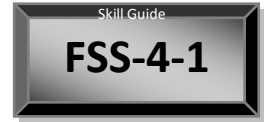

Description: This Skill Guide is intended to instruct and/or evaluate the expected actions of offensively positioned personnel when an 'abandon' the building signal is received

Performance Standards:

Abandon the Building

Task- The firefighter will demonstrate the ability to quickly exit a building in a coordinated manner.

Conditions: As a member of a team offensively positioned in a structure fire, with the Incident Commander announcing the order to 'abandon' the building the firefighter will:

Objectives			P	F
1.	Recognize the 'Abandon the Building' Signal			
	Radio Transmission	Cencom 'Warble'		
3.	Immediately locate your team and communicate the necessity to 'abandon'			
4.	Make one attempt to locate team (<60 Seconds)			
5.	Exit at the point of entry / if not possible then closest exit point			
6.	If unable to immediately exit - Declare a 'Mayday' (S.G. FSS-2-1)			
7.	After exiting - locate team (if able) and determine status of all members			
8.	Prepare for Emergency Roll Call (S.G. IMP-6B)			
9.	Move team to Division/Group Supervisor or Incident Command Post			
Performance Outcome; The firefighter shall immediately respond to the call to abandon the building, making one attempt to locate team and exit together. If unable to immediately exit the building the firefighter will declare a 'Mayday'. Communicate their status to supervisor or Incident commander after exiting the building
