**Conditions:** Following RIT Assembly, and a structure fire incident with offensively positioned teams and a firefighter emergency, the RIT will;

1.	Identify the 'Mayday' Call, and ensure it is received by the I.C.		
2.	Monitor emergency traffic, identifying L.U.N.A.R. information		
3.	Develop Rescue Action Plan, accounting for:		
	Fire Conditions and Structural Integrity (Necessity of Hose Line)		
	Location and access to the downed firefighter (Search Method)		
	Cause of the firefighter emergency and condition of the firefighter		
4.	Coordinate Rescue Action Plan with I.C.		
	I.C. / Safety Officer – Go / No Go for Rescue Attempt		
	Supervision of Rescue operation (RIT and Downed Firefighter)		
	Coordinate Rescue with Adjacent Teams and ongoing operations		
5.	Communicate Rescue Action Plan to Team		
	Assign roles specific to; forcible entry needs, method of search, and conditions		
	Communicate safety issues		
	Communicate point of entry, search method, and firefighter conditions		
6.	Communicate R.I.T. entry to Supervisor		

**Performance Outcome.** Team Leader rapidly deploys the rapid intervention team to a firefighter emergency in a coordinated and planned manner
