1.	Receive the Tactical Assignment as R.I.T.:		
	Obtain I.C. report to include:		
	Incident Action Plan and tactical objectives		
	Location and assignment of offensively positioned teams		
2.	Assemble Team and Equipment:		
	Communicate R.I.T. Assembly plan and assign team roles		
	Gather Necessary Equipment, minimum; R.I.T. Pack, T.I.C., Forcible Entry Tools		
3.	Perform 360' size-up and identify firefighter safety hazards		
4.	Coordinate risk evaluation with Incident Safety Officer		
5.	Provide Secondary means of egress for offensively positioned teams:		
	Ladders, placed at rescue angle, to each level with firefighters operating		
	Soften Structure; coordinated with I.C. ensuring ventilation is not altered		
6.	Ensure operating frequencies are continuously monitored		
7.	Maintain awareness of offensive assignments and fire conditions		
8.	Maintain readiness to deploy for a firefighter rescue		
Performance Outcome; The Team Leader effectively assembles a Rapid Intervention Team and prepares for a potential firefighter emergency based on fire conditions, building construction, and fire ground operations.
