RIT Search- Rope Assisted

Task: Given a predetermined length of rope, a RIT of two members will locate a downed firefighter while maintaining team integrity.

Conditions: In a simulated IDLH atmosphere, wearing full PPE and SCBA, with limited or zero visibility a rescue team of two will deploy a rope to keep orientation in the fire building.

6.	Team locates and assess downed firefighter per (S.G. FSS-8-1)
